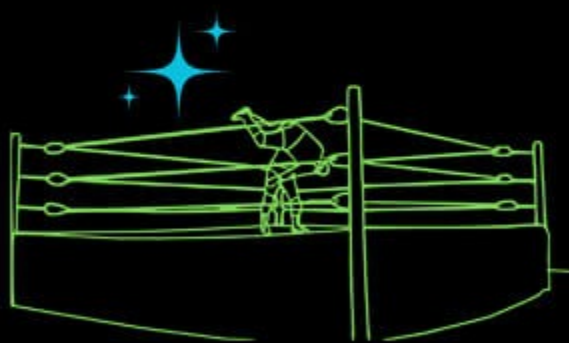

COT: Super Machine received \$1,400 when VIRUS/LPPF: Misfit Messiah hurled him out.
VIRUS: Mean Mike Eaves snatched \$1,500 when he got flipped out by VIRUS: Mike “The Mangler” Eaves.
VIRUS: Mike “The Mangler” Eaves pocketed \$1,600 after COT: “The Critic” Scott Pretzler tossed him out of the ring.
COT: “The Critic” Scott Pretzler nabbed \$1,700 when COT: Jurassic Machine tossed him onto the announcer’s table.
Æ/LPPF: Super Dazzle nabbed \$1,800 after he got thrown outside the ring by EEAmy: H2O.
COT: Jurassic Machine was awarded \$1,900 after being flung into his manager at ringside by COT: Order Machine.
WWF: Muggle Bourne received a cool \$2,000 after being tossed out of the ring by COT/LPPF/CHAMPx2: Sir Gunther Kinderwacht.
VIRUS/BURN: Croc Master was paid \$2,100 when EEAmy: Blood threw him out.
EEArmy: Blood picked up \$2,200 when he was thrown out of the ring by Jumbo Machine.
VIRUS/LPPF: Misfit Messiah grabbed an imaginary \$2,300 when COT: “The Grey Wolf” Doug McMaster threw him into some chairs at ringside.
EEArmy: H2O won \$2,400 when he got tossed into his manager at ringside by Æ: Mr. Willie Jones.
Jumbo Machine gained \$2,500 when he got thrown out by COT: Order Machine.
COT: “The Grey Wolf” Doug McMaster gained \$2,600 in imaginary earnings when he was thrown out of the ring by COT/LPPF/CHAMPx2: Sir Gunther Kinderwacht.
COT/LPPF/CHAMPx2: Sir Gunther Kinderwacht was given \$2,700 after Æ: Mr. Willie Jones flung him out.
Æ: Mr. Willie Jones was awarded \$2,800 after COT: Order Machine flung him into his manager at ringside.
COT: Order Machine was the winner of the battle royal and the \$30,000 purse, and 5 free ASL matches.

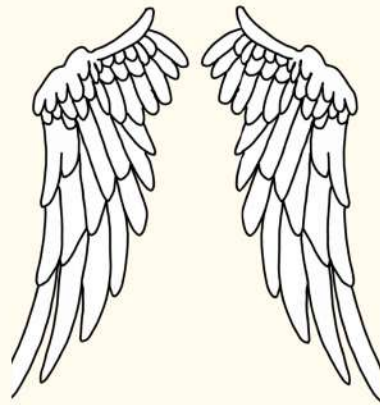

Hello, one and all, and welcome to this edition of the Angel Report and the beginning of a new era here in the All-Star League.

Each cycle, I will give the Star Award to the wrestler that has earned the highest singles strategy in the cycle before and I'm going to sign 5 free scrub matches on his behalf.

This cycle's winner is **COT/LPPF/CHAMP: Nightmare Sam Hell** who took the League Title with a 499.

Additionally, each cycle I'll add 5 matches and \$25,000 to the All-Star Jackpot (if we hit 50 cards, this is doubled).

The Jackpot is awarded as follows:

World Tag / World Six = 10%

American/Metro/Elite Titles = 10% (ea)

Gold Fed or US or National = 20%

World = 75% (in lieu of Specialty and/or Fed awards)

(The camera fades into the Yorktown arena, H2O has just won Central Plains title. The ring announcer hands him his Central Plains and Icon titles. The EE Army join H2O in the ring. Blood is wearing the Mr. ASL and Great Lakes titles. Nathan Ross is wearing the Rocky Mountain title. The crowd reaction is significantly more mixed than usual.)

Marvel: It sounds like they heard that you're leaving.

(Loud and continuous boos. H2O motions for the crowd to quiet down so he can speak.)

H2O: I understand.

(H2O nods and pauses for a moment, looking down at the ring. The crowd becomes silent and curious.)

H2O: No one is more uneasy about this than I am. No one hates change more than I do. Terrible images of everything that could possibly go wrong are locked into an endless loop in my imagination. My life has been white knuckle terror since the moment I signed up for the IWAR draft. This could be the biggest mistake of my career. I've enjoyed two years of uninterrupted success. It would be comfortable to stay here. No one in the ASL can stop me from padding my resume and adding more gold to my trophy case.

(A substantial number of fans chant "Stay! Stay! Stay!")

H2O: And that is exactly why I have to go. It wasn't the lure of victories, titles, or awards that dragged me out of retirement. I had already won more of those than I could count. No. I had to come back to prove myself against new competition. To prove to a new generation that the world hadn't passed me by. To make sure that the fans didn't forget me. To prove to myself that no matter how much time passes, no matter who retires and who debuts, no matter what style of wrestling or promoting is in fashion, I am not a fai ...

(H2O sneers. H2O has decisively won the crowd back by this point. A chant of "Not A Failure!" echoes through the arena. H2O is clearly touched and soaks it in for a moment.)

Marvel: You know that Gunther is going to claim that he ran you out of the ASL.

H2O: Let him talk. Every time I beat him at a Pay Per View, his bravado dissolved, revealing that there was never anything behind the boring, repetitive, toothless threats. And when he does rant about being the reason I left, in a way, he'll be right. **He simply wasn't a big enough challenge to keep me here. He wasn't interesting or dynamic enough to give me a reason to stay.**

Nathan Ross: That's cold. Gunther and the Tyrants are some of the biggest stars in the industry.

Blood: Is Gunther even a Tyrant anymore? The last I heard, his stable initials were COT/LPPF/Antidisestablishmentarianism/ Supercalifragilisticexpialidocious/CHUMP2.

H2O: In all seriousness, Gunther, Stryker, you are great competitors. Your accomplishments speak for themselves. And I have no doubt that wrestling history will record that you were great. But over the last two years, I've seen you as men. And you are not great men. You're delusional, petty, graceless, caricatures. History will remember that too.

(The fans start to chant Eradicate! Eradicate! Eradicate)

H2O: I'm leaving in a few months, but I still have a few things to take care of before then. And that brings me to the next challenger for my Icon Title. Shoestring, you're right, we are nothing alike. Nothing.

(H2O stares into the camera.)

H2O: You pretend that you don't have a choice in order to avoid accountability for your own despicable actions. You sell children poison that rots their bodies, hearts, and minds. But you aren't man enough to take responsibility for your own sins. You take shortcuts because you "need" a little release. You blame your upbringing, and the misfortune that you faced as a youth. But in reality, you're just a weak, selfish, self-indulgent, coward.

(H2O shakes his head in disgust.)

H2O: You're right, we are absolutely nothing alike. Yes, I talk as if I had a choice. I've made choices, hard choices, every single day of my career. I could easily have drowned in a sea of insecurities, doubts, and self-loathing. BUT I CHOSE TO SWIM. It would have been simple to accept that my critics were right, that I'd never be any good, that I didn't belong in the wrestling ring. BUT I CHOSE TO FIGHT BACK AND TO OVERCOME THEIR VENOM. Every time I lost, broke a bone, suffered burns across my skin, needed stitches to keep my blood inside my body, I could have fallen into the abyss. BUT I CHOSE TO CLIMB BACK UP AND TO PUNCH LIFE IN THE NOSE. At any point, I could have chosen the easy path, but that way led to madness and despair. It led to a pitiful existence like yours. BUT INSTEAD, I CHOSE TO ERADICATE!

(The fans chant "Eradicate! Eradicate! Eradicate!" more loudly than before.)

Marvel: Well, maybe you choose a little bit of madness.

(H2O rolls his eyes at Marvel.)

H2O: Shoestring, at the Pay Per View, I am going to make another choice. And this one time, you really aren't going to have a choice at all. I'm going to choose to beat you senseless and to retain the Icon title. You, on the other hand, are going to take the beating of your life, but don't worry, it's not your fault, it's foreordained. Shoestring, PREPARE TO BE ERADICATED, it's not like you have any other choice.

(H2O laughs.)

H2O: Gunther, Sam Warner, you're competing for the honor of being the last challenger that I defend the Icon title against. Sam, we have unfinished business. If you beat Gunther, the only thing that you are going to secure is a much-deserved reckoning. Kidwatcher, if you beat Sam, you'll earn the opportunity to lose to this "rookie" one last time, on my way out. Either way I win. Either way, you are ALL WASHED UP. Gunther or Sam Warner, one of you had better PREPARE TO BE ERADICATED. Shoestring, I guess we can say that the choice is theirs.

(H2O and the EE Army leave through the crowd as the camera fades out.)

New ASL Southeast Champion
Battle Royal Winner: Solomon Grundy
Manager: Klarion the Witch Boy

[The cameras cut to the entrance stage. Fog rolls across the floor as Klarion the Witch Boy steps into view, Teekl perched on his shoulder. Beside him stands Solomon Grundy, the new ASL Southeast Regional Champion. The oversized championship belt rests across Grundy's shoulder while a giant check for \$30,000 leans against the stage.]

KLARION:
Shanghai... did you have fun.

(Klarion grins from ear to ear.)

You all watched wrestler after wrestler fly over the ropes. Some landed in chairs. Some landed on the ring steps. One poor fool landed in the audience.

(He laughs.)

And who was still standing when it was all over.

(Klarion dramatically presents Grundy.)

My monster.

(The crowd boos as Grundy slowly lifts the Southeast Championship.)

SOLOMON GRUNDY:
Grundy throw everybody.

KLARION:
That's right. Doug McMaster... Blood... Sinister Steve Stryker... H2O...

(He counts them off on his fingers.)

They all learned the same lesson.

(He looks into the camera.)

Never stand between Solomon Grundy and a championship.

(Grundy looks down at the oversized prize check.)

SOLOMON GRUNDY:
Magic boy... thirty thousand buy lots food.

KLARION:
More than food.

(He smiles mischievously.)

It buys power. Influence. More magic...
...and maybe a few fish for Teekl.

(Teekl purrs.)

[Klarion suddenly becomes serious.]

VIRUS is spreading.

(He points to the VIRUS logo stitched onto his cape.)

Last month, Solomon Grundy crushed Blood to win the Central Plains Championship.

(He holds up one finger.)

This month...

(He raises a second finger.)

...he wins the biggest battle royal in ASL history and walks away with the Southeast Championship.

[Klarion steps aside as Grundy walks toward the camera.]

SOLOMON GRUNDY:
Grundy got two belts.

(He smiles his crooked, unsettling grin.)

Grundy want more.

KLARION:
Did you hear that.
The zombie doesn't want to rest.
He wants to collect championships.

(Klarion leans into the camera.)

So every regional champion... every battle royal winner... every so-called giant of the All-Star League...

(He points back at Grundy.)

Be careful.

Because if you hear heavy footsteps behind you...

(Grundy tightens his grip on the Southeast Championship.)

SOLOMON GRUNDY:
Grundy coming.

[Grundy lets out a thunderous roar as Klarion laughs wildly. The camera fades to black with the VIRUS logo filling the screen.]

The lights come up.

There is no music.

No pyro.

No dramatic video package.

Instead, a single man walks onto the stage carrying what appears to be a laptop bag, wearing cargo shorts, an obscure graphic T-shirt, fingerless gloves, and the unmistakable facial expression of someone who has just discovered a grammatical error in a stranger's Facebook comment.

He stops halfway down the ramp.

Raises one finger.

And waits.

The crowd begins to boo.

He looks genuinely offended.

“Civilians.”

More boos.

He raises the finger higher.

“I said... CIVILIANS.”

The crowd gets louder.

He nods slowly, as though they have finally demonstrated sufficient comprehension.

“Before we proceed, there is one thing you are going to do.”

He points directly into the camera.

“You are going to acknowledge your OGT.”

The crowd boos even louder.

He looks around, confused.

“No, no, no. You're doing this wrong.”

He adjusts his glasses.

“I said... ACKNOWLEDGE YOUR OGT!”

The crowd begins chanting, sarcastically:

“OGT! OGT! OGT!”

He smiles.

Not because they're cheering.

Because they have finally obeyed.

“See? Was that so difficult?”

He steps into the ring and immediately begins pacing.

“Now, I realize some of you civilians may be wondering, ‘Who is this guy?’”

He stops.

Raises his finger.

“Actually...”

The crowd groans.

“...that question demonstrates precisely why I'm here.”

He nods knowingly.

"You don't know."

"And that's okay."

He smiles condescendingly.

"Because I do."

The crowd boos.

"Ladies and gentlemen, civilians, casuals, tourists, seasonal fans, people who were dragged here by friends, people who have somehow watched professional wrestling for forty one years and STILL don't understand how a wristlock works..."

He gestures dismissively toward the crowd.

"...welcome to the All Star League."

He pauses.

"Now, I know what you're thinking."

Another finger.

"OGT, what makes you qualified to gatekeep the ASL?"

He scoffs.

"Everything."

"I have studied this league."

He taps his temple.

"I have studied its history. Its competitors. Its systems. Its traditions. Its obscure little nuances that none of you have even noticed because you were too busy enjoying yourselves."

He looks disgusted by the concept.

"And that brings me to my primary responsibility."

He leans over the ropes.

"You civilians are having too much fun."

Boos.

"WAY too much fun."

He shakes his head.

"You come into the All Star League, you watch a couple matches, you learn three wrestler names, you memorize one catchphrase, and suddenly you think you're part of the community."

He laughs.

"No."

Finger up.

"Actually, you are not."

The crowd starts chanting again.

"OGT! OGT! OGT!"

He holds up both hands.

"Please. Please. One at a time."

He waits for them to settle.

“Because that's another thing we're going to establish here.”

He points around the arena.

“You don't get to decide what is cool.”

“You don't get to decide who is underrated.”

“You don't get to decide which wrestler deserves a push.”

The boos grow.

“You don't get to say, ‘Hey, I just like this guy because he's entertaining.’”

He looks personally wounded.

“That is not how this works.”

He takes a deep breath.

“You must first understand the lore.”

“You must understand the history.”

He points.

“You must know the context.”

Another point.

“You must have seen the obscure match from twelve years ago in a building that no longer exists.”

He nods.

“THEN you may form an opinion.”

The crowd begins chanting:

“OGT! OGT! OGT!”

He smiles smugly.

“Exactly.”

He straightens his shirt.

“Now we're getting somewhere.”

He begins pacing again.

“I am here to protect the All Star League from civilians who think they can simply walk in here and enjoy themselves.”

He shakes his head.

“This is a sacred institution.”

A pause.

“And I am its most important authority.”

The crowd laughs.

OGT's face drops.

“Excuse me?”

He points accusingly at the audience.

“Did I hear laughter?”

He slowly removes his glasses.

“That's interesting.”

He stares into the crowd.

“Because I don't remember asking for your opinion.”

The crowd explodes.
OGT puts his glasses back on.

“From this day forward, I will be watching.”
He points toward the locker room.
“I will be listening.”
He points toward the audience.
“And most importantly...”
He slowly turns toward the camera.
“I will be correcting.”
A sinister smile.

“You may not like me.”
“You may think I'm annoying.”
“You may even desperately wish I would stop talking.”
“But here's the thing, civilians.”
He raises one finger one final time.

“You don't get to decide.”
He spreads his arms.
“I do.”

The crowd is now chanting his initials at full volume, revealing their deep desperation to be monitored at all times.

“OGT! OGT! OGT! OGT!”

OGT closes his eyes.
Smiles.
And savors it.

“That's right.”
He slowly points toward himself.
“Your OGT has arrived.”
A pause.
“And unfortunately for all of you...”
He adjusts his glasses.
“...you're going to learn something.”



“The Gold Standard of Cobra”

[The arena lights dim. A lone spotlight shines on the entrance as Storm Shadow emerges, dressed in pristine white, the IWA Gold Federation Championship draped over his shoulder. Walking a step behind him is Cobra Commander, clad in ceremonial Cobra attire, applauding his champion with theatrical enthusiasm.]

The crowd erupts into deafening boos.

Storm Shadow silently enters the ring and stands motionless, his eyes fixed on the hard camera.

Cobra Commander accepts a microphone.

COBRA COMMANDER:

Citizens of the Gold Federation and Triple Crown Network ... behold perfection.

(He gestures toward the championship.)

While G.I. Joe celebrates participation trophies and moral victories...

Cobra collects gold.

(The boos grow louder.)

The July cycle proved what I have proclaimed for months. Storm Shadow is no ordinary wrestler. He is a precision instrument. A flawless weapon.

(Cobra Commander points to the championship belt.)

That championship does not belong to the Gold Federation...

...the Gold Federation belongs to Storm Shadow.

Storm Shadow slowly removes the title from his shoulder and raises it overhead.

COBRA COMMANDER:

Every challenger believed they could solve the Storm Shadow puzzle.

They all discovered the same painful truth.

You cannot outfight perfection.

You cannot outthink discipline.

And you certainly cannot survive...

(He pauses dramatically.)

...the Silent Assassin.

The crowd begins chanting:

“G.I. JOE! G.I. JOE!”

Storm Shadow remains completely unfazed.

Cobra Commander chuckles.

COBRA COMMANDER:

Ah yes... chant for your heroes.

Roadblock has championships.

Snake-Eyes has championships.

But there is one championship G.I. Joe cannot claim.

(He taps the Gold Federation title.)

[SVL play by play announcer Lifeline reminds the TV audience that Roadblock won the Gold Federation title last month.]

COBRA COMMANDER:

This.

The symbol that proves Cobra possesses the finest wrestler in the entire Imaginary Wrestling Association.

Storm Shadow slowly unsheathes his katana just enough for the steel to glimmer beneath the arena lights before calmly sliding it back into its scabbard.

COBRA COMMANDER:

Let every federation send its greatest.

Let every league crown its champions.

They will all learn the same lesson...

(He steps beside Storm Shadow and raises the champion's arm.)

When the shadow falls...

...gold belongs to Cobra.

Storm Shadow raises the IWA Gold Federation Championship one final time as Cobra Commander throws both arms triumphantly into the air. The crowd rains down boos while the Cobra banner fills the video screen and SVL cuts to commercial.

SUPER DAZZLE



Super Dazzle versus Blood.... this cycle for the All-Star Championship. May the best man win, amigo.

In just a couple months' time, I'll be facing Sir Gunther Kinderwacht for the opportunity to become the new #1 contender to the ICON Heavyweight Title - and, that's sure to be a renewed rivalry that turns into an instant classic.... but, first, in just a few short weeks we'll find out if that opportunity comes against H2O or does it come against Shoestring. Whichever of you it is, just remember that I'm waiting right around the corner. Consider yourselves Warned!

Backstabba & Bootleg walk through a neighborhood and address the camera

Backstabba: "The brass wanted another video, so here it is."

Bootleg: "We got some gold, we don't see anyone here doing anything about it or saying s***, so it's time to add some more gold to the fam"

Backstabba: "So off to battle **Richter & Thorne** - we are off to battle you guys in the LWL - PWI titles or not - get ready to pay up son!"



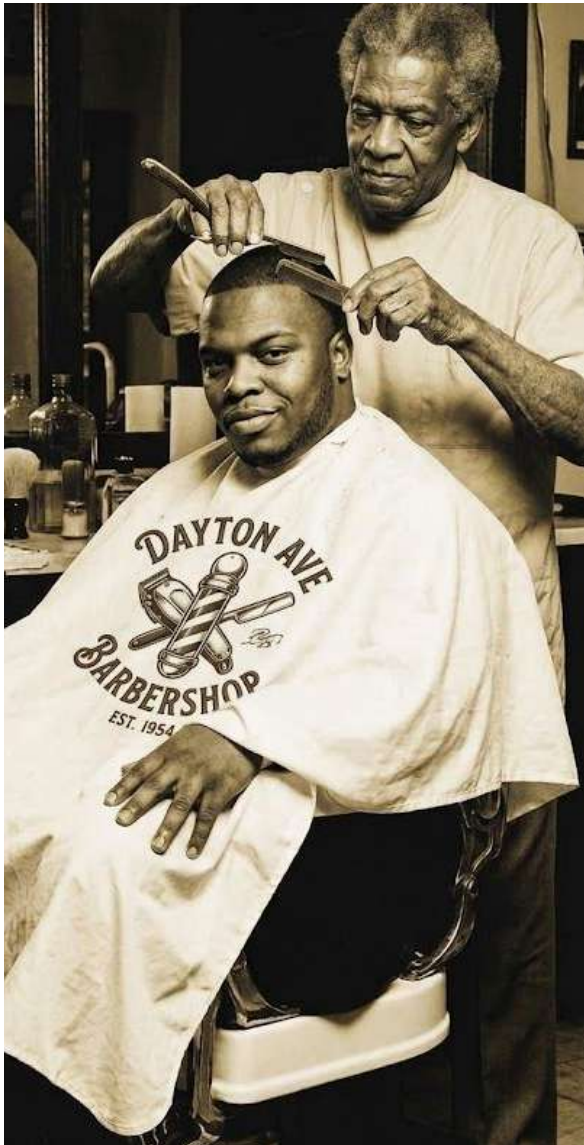
Shoestring is at the barbershop.

"**H2O**, I saw your little stoner movie skit man, but if I were in a movie Friday probably would have been the one. I mean I like those joints, but c'mon.

"I get it man, you've had the title and all the challengers just sat there and didn't say anything and you always have Gunther bothering you and you just want to move onto being the champ. So yeah, even though you are a corn ball, I can see why you are acting that way. I know you aren't corny in the ring I've seen you beat some real ones..

"So when we meet for that **ICON Heavyweight Title** - know that we will have the complete set of ICON titles. Then what else will there be to do here? Now if your little buddies want to jump in, know that Bootleg and Backstabba are always lurking.

Shoestring takes the straight razor and looks into the camera, then it fades

Next time I go there, my ASL buddy Phat Hen is coming along, but I'll make sure to tell Darrell in the back that you're the guest, not the entrée!



"Big Deal in a Small Town" Chud Watkins

Professor Vitali Medved stands in the ASL ring beside Jumbo Machine, whose enormous frame casts a shadow over three masked newcomers. Medved spreads his arms proudly. "Comrades! Today the Yamazaki Corporation has authorized a significant capital expenditure. Please welcome Order Machine, who shall increase organization one additional unit at a time! Super Machine, who has tested positively for being above average in every measurable category! And Jurassic Machine..." He pauses dramatically. "...who is from the Jurassic Department." Jumbo Machine nods enthusiastically and walks down the line. He clasps Order Machine's hand. "Good to see you again." Order Machine nods back. Jumbo turns to Super Machine. "It's been too long." Super Machine returns the handshake. Then Jumbo stops in front of Jurassic Machine and tilts his head. Jurassic Machine stares silently through the mask. Jumbo looks back at Medved. "Professor... I don't know this one." Medved blinks in genuine confusion. "Of course you do. He is Jurassic Machine." Jumbo shrugs. "No, I'm fairly certain I'd remember meeting someone called Jurassic Machine." Medved begins frantically flipping through a three-ring binder labeled **JURASSIC MACHINE DOCUMENTATION**, finding only blank pages, a receipt for binder clips, and a recipe for cabbage soup. "Impossible! The paperwork clearly indicates Jurassic Machine exists!" Jumbo folds his arms. "I'm not arguing that he exists. I'm saying I've never met him." Jurassic Machine finally raises one finger. "First day." Medved slams the binder shut. "AH! Excellent! A completely ordinary explanation! There has been no continuity anomaly whatsoever! Everyone please stop asking perfectly reasonable questions and instead welcome the newest member of the Machine family!" Jumbo immediately smiles, extends his hand, and says, "Well then... nice to meet you." Jurassic Machine shakes it. "Likewise." Medved beams with relief. "You see? Science triumphs again."

After a commercial, Doug McMaster stands alone in the ring, microphone in hand, as the crowd chants his name.

"Last month, Sir Gunther got the better of me. That's the truth, and I've never been afraid to tell the truth. But before anybody starts talking like I got run over, let's remember what actually happened. It took almost thirty minutes before he finally caught me with the Stun Gunn. Thirty minutes of fighting, thirty minutes of surviving, thirty minutes of proving that I belong in the ring with one of the toughest men in this sport. He beat me, but he didn't break me. Now we get another chance, and this time the pressure isn't on me—it's on him. Because now he knows exactly what he's getting into. He knows what it feels like when I keep coming after him. He knows what it's like to have to earn every inch. And this month, if I get my hands locked together, there won't be any debate about who's in control. Sir Gunther, you better be ready to tap out... or pass out... because when the Masterlock is cinched in, there aren't any other options."



Backstage, a television hangs from the wall showing Sir Gunther and Doug McMaster trading heavy forearms in the center of the ring. He returns to silently guarding Steve's office.

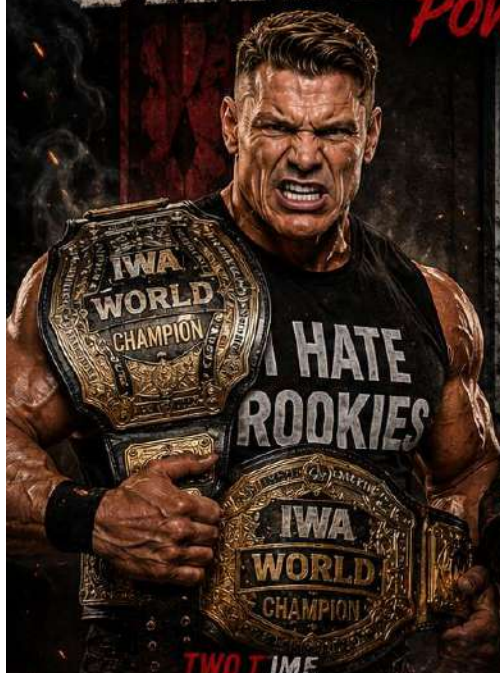

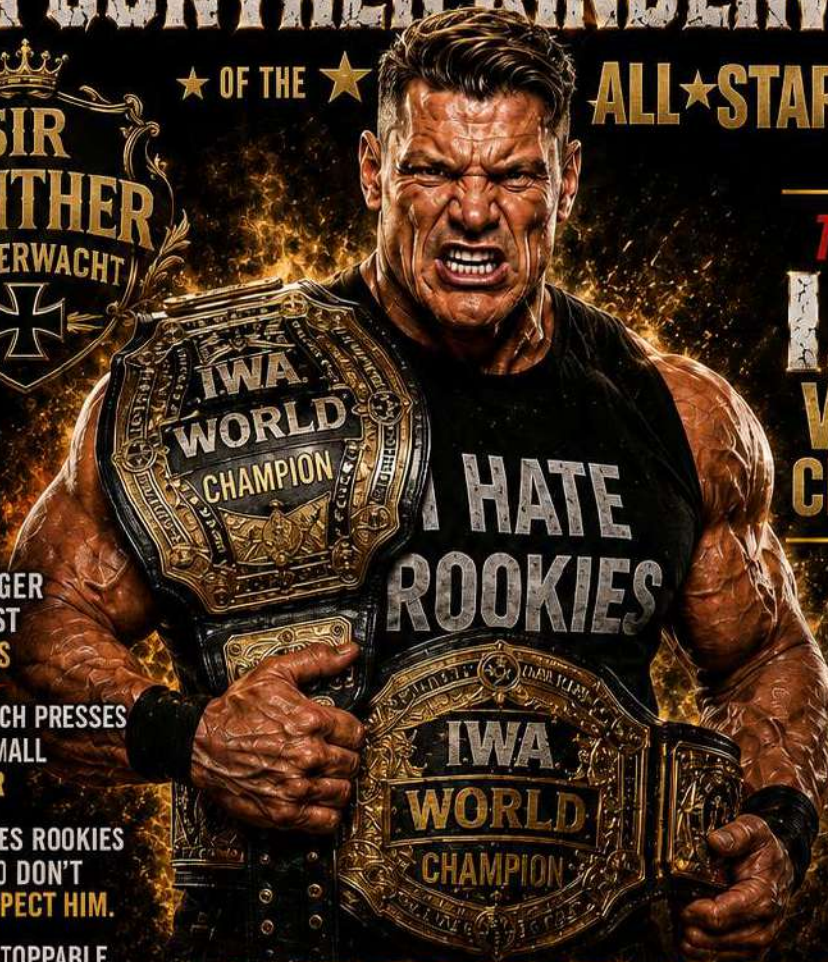
