The Singles Division has taken on a distinctly volatile shape this cycle, with one undisputed apex predator at the top and a chaotic swarm of contenders clawing for position beneath him.

Cobra stands alone at 40 points, a cold-blooded tyrant whose grip on the division feels absolute. Every match is a constriction, every victory a tightening coil. He is the standard, the fear, and the ceiling all at once.

Behind him, Legend of the Past sits at 32.5, proving that old myths don't fade — they return. His performances feel like echoes from forgotten eras, each one shaking the present.

Kevin Von Erich Clapton holds strong at 30, a righteous storm gathering force. He's not just climbing; he's carving a path through anyone who dares stand in front of him.

The 25-point tier is a dangerous crossroads featuring Ben Dead and They Might Be Giants Gonzalez. One is a walking omen, the other a seismic force. Both are close enough to strike at the throne if momentum swings their way.

Just behind them, Mike "The SISOShammer" Cook sits at 22.5, a disruptor whose hammer-swinging chaos can rewrite a cycle in an instant.

The 20-point duo — Disciple of Terror 14 and Panic! At the Disco Inferno — represent two very different brands of danger: one calculated and shadow-born, the other explosive and unpredictable. Either one could surge with a single breakout performance.

The 17.5-point cluster is a three-way demonic brawl: "Wrestling Demon" Alcohol, "Wrestling Demon" Money, and KOTR Champ Mike Cook. Each brings a different flavor of menace, and all three are poised to cause havoc in the mid-card.

Overall, the division is defined by one dominant ruler, two elite pursuers, and a crowded, unstable middle tier where every cycle threatens to flip the hierarchy upside down. The Graveyard is restless — and the next update could be catastrophic.



💀 THE CASKET ROYALE — RUMBLER STANDINGS 💀

Should you seek civilization, order, or a modicum of sportsmanlike conduct, the Rumbler Division is emphatically not for you. This is a lawless wasteland wherein a rotating roster of brutalists enters a ring encircled by open caskets — each one yawning and ready — and proceeds to eliminate one another by any means the officials haven't yet specifically prohibited. The last Rumbler standing, or indeed crawling, claims the points. The caskets, on occasion, are not left empty. We do not ask questions.

RUMBLER DIVISION POINTS LEADER: COBRA — 50 POINTS. The Rumbler Division has taken on a brutally lopsided shape this cycle, defined almost entirely by one monstrous presence at the top and a tightly packed cluster of survivors beneath him.

Cobra sits at a towering **50 points**, a level of dominance that feels less like competition and more like a reign of terror. Every appearance in the pit is a constriction, every victory a reminder that the serpent king is operating on a different plane. He isn't just leading — he's suffocating the division.

Below him, the rest of the field forms a **five-way deadlock at 10 points**, each competitor fighting not for supremacy, but for relevance in the shadow of Cobra's rule.

Erik Kyle continues his steady march, a grinder who refuses to be erased. **Legend of the Past** remains an ever-present myth, proving that even ancient forces can survive the chaos. **Slaughter** brings raw brutality, always one rampage away from shaking the hierarchy. **The Headless Horseman** charges blindly into the fray, unpredictable and haunting. **Mort Ician** lurks with cold precision, a threat waiting for the right moment to freeze the field.

Together, they form a volatile cluster — dangerous, determined, and desperate to break free from the serpent's chokehold.

But make no mistake: the story of this cycle is Cobra. The pit belongs to him, and until someone finds a way to cut the head off the king, the Rumbler Division will continue to revolve around his venomous orbit.



≡ THE CRYPT DUOS — TAG TEAM RANKINGS ≡

The tag team competition within the CFL operates on a single, unspoken covenant: *trust your partner, for there is no one else*. In practice, however, betrayal is a currency more freely traded here than victories, and it carries the faint, lingering perfume of formaldehyde. Every championship pairing in the Crypt Duos division has, at some point, questioned whether their partner intends to tag in — or simply walk away and let the wolves have their meal. Henceforth, all tag teams are advised to sleep with one eye open. Both eyes, if you have them.

Below them, the division collapses into a massive ten-point deadlock, a tangled web of wildly different pairings, each dangerous in its own way.

Furious George & Kevin Mash bring rage and muscle. Mr. Sam Bullard & Cobra combine discipline with venomous precision. Nervous Rex & Disciple of Terror 18 are unstable, twitchy, and terrifying. Damien Judas Priest & Mike “100th Wrestler” Cook blend cult charisma with veteran grit. The Prodigy & 3 to Tango swing between brilliance and chaos. The Blue Chipper & Mike “Retirement Tour” Cook mix rising talent with fading legend. Raven’s Flock of Seagulls & “The Teamster” Mike Cook are bizarre, frantic, and surprisingly effective. Death Lord & Mike “100th Wrestler” Cook operate with cold calculation. Damian Judas Priest & Toy are unpredictable and theatrically dangerous. Mr. Stripes & Mr. Stars bring explosive patriotic fury.

It’s a division defined by one clear leader and a massive, volatile middle tier where every team is one breakout cycle away from rewriting the standings. The tag landscape is unstable, combustible, and primed for upheaval — exactly the kind of battlefield the CFL thrives on.

The next cycle won’t just shift the hierarchy. It might detonate it.

If the tag team division is a conversation with treachery, then the Trio Division is a full séance — the most chaotic, ungovernable, and frankly transfixing spectacle in all of sports today. Pigskin — appears in the Trio standings alongside Raven’s Flock of Seagulls and “The Teamster” Mike Cook. *The Commissioner competes where the Ledger demands. No explanation shall be furnished.*

At the summit, **Nervous Rex, Disciple of Terror 18 & Storm God** stand tall at **30 points**, a trio powered by anxiety, discipline, and divine wrath. Their chemistry is unstable but devastating — every match feels like a storm front rolling through the Graveyard. They are the division’s current apex, and every other team is forced to measure themselves against this chaotic holy terror.

Just behind them at **22.5**, **Hinder Mahal, Scorch & “#1 Stable Leader” Mike Cook** form the division’s most balanced threat. Fire, fury, and leadership combine into a trio built for sustained

momentum. Cook's command keeps the chaos focused, and when they're aligned, they look like the only squad capable of challenging the top.

The **17.5-point tier** belongs to **Damian Judas Priest, Toy & The Holy Trinity**, a spiritually unstable combination of dark sermons, wild unpredictability, and divine force. They don't just fight — they preach, they perform, and they overwhelm. When their energy syncs, they're terrifying.

Below them, the division collapses into a massive **10-point cluster**, a chaotic middle class where every trio is one breakout cycle away from rewriting the hierarchy. It's a mix of bruisers, giants, cultists, comedians, union warriors, funk monsters, and pure chaos:

- **Terror Warrior 2, Mark Henry Rollins & Bullet For My Greg Valentine** bring relentless force.
- **Furious George, The Teaming Thing & Nervous Rex** are volatile and explosive.
- **Big Easy Bossman Bill Williams, Colossal Erik Kloiber & The Giant Andrew Holubowski** form a literal wall of muscle.

In the Coffin Filler League, alliances of three or more wrestlers are not called stables. They are called **Covens** — for they gather in the dark, they commune over shared purpose, and they exercise an influence upon the CFL landscape that no solitary competitor could hope to match. A Coven's power is measured by the sum of its combined victories, the titles held by its members, and its **Souls Claimed** — a proprietary metric by which the Commissioner's office tallies the opponents a Coven has, through direct action, removed from competition for a period of no less than thirty days. The methodology is rigorous. The results are damning.

The Stable Division has taken on a towering, almost mythic shape this cycle, defined by one overwhelming super-power at the top and a series of factions fighting for survival beneath its shadow.

At the summit sits **COT**, an empire with a staggering **531.35 points** — a number so large it feels less like a score and more like a declaration of ownership. COT doesn't just lead the division; they dominate it with depth, consistency, and a relentless ability to generate points across every category. The Graveyard bends around them. Every storyline, every rivalry, every cycle eventually runs through COT.

Far below, but still clearly ahead of the rest, **EDGE** holds **276.7 points**, a sharp, rising force carving out its own territory. They aren't close enough to threaten COT's throne yet, but they've separated themselves from the pack with momentum, cohesion, and a steady climb that feels inevitable. If any stable is building toward a future challenge, it's EDGE.

The next tier belongs to **SOS** at **182.35**, a resilient faction that refuses to fade. They punch above their weight, spoil bigger stables' plans, and remain the division's most dangerous disruptor. SOS doesn't dominate — they destabilize, and that makes them essential to the league's balance.

Behind them, **Independent** sits at **97**, a collective of lone wolves, outcasts, and freelancers who somehow make the chaos work. They're unpredictable, volatile, and capable of shocking the

upper stables when the grave soil shifts. No one ever knows what Independent will do next — including Independent.

The lower tier is defined by two fledgling factions: **AE** at **35**, a small but stubborn presence with flashes of brilliance, and **STUN** at **7.5**, a newborn stable still finding its identity. Their numbers are small, but the Graveyard has seen underdogs rise before. Every empire starts somewhere.

Overall, the Stable Division is a story of **one colossal titan, two rising challengers, one dangerous spoiler, and two developing factions** trying to carve out space in a landscape ruled by giants. The next cycle won't dethrone COT — but it may reveal who's truly capable of chasing them.



THE ROYAL RUMBLE RETURNS

A proclamation from the Commissioner's Office, inscribed in the Ledger, sealed with the CFL seal, and dispatched to every corner of the known and unknowable wrestling world.

The Coffin Filler League makes its proclamation to the faithful wretched: the **CFL Royal Rumble** rises once more from its buried slumber, descending upon **August 2026 cycle** with all the chaos, carnage, and consequence this league has always demanded of its warriors. The earth has rested. The caskets have waited. The Rumble — patient as the grave itself — now stirs. Heed this dispatch, all who would test themselves against the assembled wretched of the CFL. The August cycle draws near. Glory — and considerable currency — awaits those bold enough to enter.

- **GRAVEYARD TAG TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP — Defended by: Onslaught & Slaughter. The**
most aggressively named tag partnership permissible under CFL bylaws. Two men. One title. Infinite menace. The Commissioner finds the symmetry of their names aesthetically pleasing and has said as much in writing.

⌘ PUBLICATION & STANDINGS BONUS ⌘

WINNERS SHALL BE PUBLISHED IN THE FOLLOWING CYCLE’S CHRONICLE — their names inscribed in the permanent record of the Coffin Filler League for all eternity, or until the next printing, whichever comes first. The Ledger does not differentiate. Both are forever.

Furthermore, heed the following decrees, inscribed in the Ledger without possibility of appeal or amendment:
