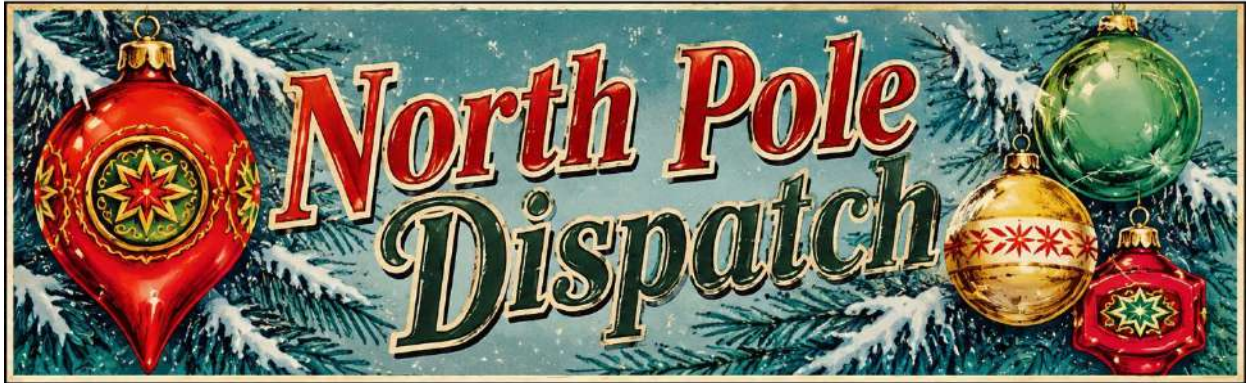

5. **Gone Aria** – *The Boomtown Champion has become one of the league's coldest competitors. Every title defense seems to come with another stocking full of disappointment for whoever dares challenge him.*
