1. Fire – *When the lights went dark and the carnival music began to play, Fire became the monster lurking beneath the Big Top. The League Champion tore through Masked Hound Spike, The Deranged Mechanic, Forgiven Faith, The Undertaker (twice), Masked Warrior, Zipperface, Shawn Steel, Bobby Colfax, Leon Walls, and battled Carter Matthews, PhD to a no contest. Every challenger entered the funhouse... few ever found the exit.*

2. "Ultra-Violent" Chico Salazar – *No act drew more screams than Chico Salazar. Nearly every card featured another victim left crumpled in the center ring as he carved through the competition with ruthless efficiency. His only blemish came at the hands of Sgt. Slammer after an otherwise terrifying campaign.*

3. The Deranged Mechanic – The carnival's mad inventor kept winding the gears all cycle long. Victories over Sgt. Slammer, Shedrick Porter, Dream Denied, The Undertaker, Graft the Pyromaniac, Death Gambler, Gregory the Gigantic, and Brotherhood of Death proved the Mechanic remains one of the most dangerous attractions under the tent.

4. Sadistic Syd Slaughter – If the midway had an executioner, it would be Sadistic Syd Slaughter. He stalked one opponent after another, collecting victories with frightening consistency while reminding everyone why crossing his path is a dangerous decision.

5. Masked Warrior – Silent. Methodical. Relentless. The Rocky Mountains Champion carved a path through elite competition, defeating The Deranged Mechanic, Regular Machine, Vlad Dracul, Midori Porter, and Glass City Assassin Nihilism before finally falling to Fire in a championship-caliber showdown.

6. Forgiven Faith – Even inside this twisted carnival, Forgiven Faith refused to be swallowed whole. Victories over The Deranged Mechanic, Ruckus Scarsdale, Reggie Brown, The Archangel, and a Battle Royal triumph kept him among the cycle's biggest headliners.

7. Buffo – The evil clowns finally had the crowd gasping instead of laughing. Buffo's shocking Northeast Championship victory over Fire sent a chill through the entire

midway and reminded everyone that beneath the greasepaint lurks genuine danger.

8. Bozo Dubbed Over – *The ringleader of the clown parade continued to spread chaos beneath the striped tent. Between successful championship defenses and a hard-fought draw against Forgiven Faith, Bozo ensured the evil clowns remained the face of the tag team division while proving he can stand on his own when the spotlight finds him.*

9. Tinkles – *Don't let the painted smile fool you. Tinkles delivered one sinister performance after another, defending championship gold while picking up an impressive singles victory over Dream Denied. Every appearance felt like another ride through the carnival's haunted funhouse.*

10. "South Side" Reggie Brown – *Reggie fought through one of the toughest schedules of the cycle. Victories over Dream Denied, Brotherhood of Death, Gregory the Gigantic, and Mugzy kept him firmly among the league's elite, even as the shadows beneath the Big Top continued to grow darker around him.*

THE BIG TOP TEN – Tag Teams

1. Bozo Dubbed Over & Monkhatyn Biligbataar in a Machine Mask – *The League Tag Team Champions turned the Big Top into their own house of horrors. Successful title defenses over Super Shadow Machine & Sprinkles, Glass City Assassin Nihilism & Regular Machine, Dream Denied & Shawn Steel, and*

Chicken Peter & Pete Laphroaig kept the championship belts locked inside the clown car.

2. Tinkles & Tenzin Biligbataar in a Machine Mask – The Television Tag Team Champions kept the midway laughing...right before the screams began. A successful title defense, another convincing victory, and hard-fought draws against Bozo Dubbed Over's team and Dude Mann & Guy Mann made them one of the busiest acts under the striped tent.

3. Buffo & Bongo – Sometimes even clowns turn on each other. Although they came up short against the Television Champions, Buffo and Bongo remain one of the carnival's most entertaining, and dangerous, duos whenever the spotlight finds them.

4. Glass City Assassin Nihilism & Regular Machine – Cold, calculating, and built for destruction. They challenged the League Champions for the gold and never looked intimidated, proving they're only one good run away from another title opportunity.

5. Glass City Assassin Sabotage & Boring Machine – The carnival's mechanical monsters nearly stole the show. Even in defeat against the Television Champions, they demonstrated enough chemistry to remain a serious threat in the division.

6. Josh Golly & Alex Medved in a Machine Mask – One step away from pulling off the impossible. They pushed the League

Champions to a no contest, proving the carnival's biggest attraction can still be challenged.

7. Dude Mann & Guy Mann – The Mann brothers refused to become victims of the funhouse. A draw with the Television Champions showed this team can survive even the most twisted attractions beneath the Big Top.

8. Dream Denied & Shawn Steel – Their trip through the carnival ended in disaster. A championship loss to Bozo Dubbed Over and Monkhatyn Biligbataar leaves this duo searching for another ticket back into title contention.

9. Super Shadow Machine & Sprinkles – They wandered into the clowns' funhouse and never quite found the exit. Despite the championship defeat, this pairing remains capable of spoiling anyone's night with another opportunity.

10. Chicken Peter & Pete Laphroaig – Their ride through the midway ended with a frightening collision against the League Champions. They didn't leave with championship gold, but they showed enough grit to earn another trip beneath the Big Top.

THE BIG TOP TEN – Six-Man Teams

1. Doug McMaster · Buffo · Bongo – The League Six-Man Champions remain the headliners beneath the Big Top after defeating the Television Champions. The carnival still belongs to these three.

2. Mike Eaves · Forgiven Faith · Mr. Eaves – The Television Champions came up short in the showdown with the League Champions, but remain one of the league's most dangerous trios.

3. Scruffy the Clown · Soggy the Clown · Foamy the Clown – Three clowns who look like they crawled out of the carnival's forgotten midway. They may not win beauty contests, but they'll leave audiences wondering what nightmare they just witnessed.

4. Jake Jeckel · Jack Jeckel · Arthur Fleck – Chaos follows wherever this trio performs. Equal parts mayhem and madness, these three seem to enjoy unsettling the crowd as much as defeating opponents.

5. Mr. Happy · Carnival Carl · Big Top Bingo – Don't let the names fool you. Their painted smiles hide three of the eeriest attractions lurking beneath the striped tent.

6. Ronald McDonald · Doink · Clownado – Three familiar faces twisted into something much darker. Their arrival usually signals that someone is about to have a very bad evening.

7. The Jester · The Ace of Knaves · The Trickster – Masters of deception, distractions, and psychological warfare. They'd rather play mind games than wrestle by the rules.

8. Stitches · Cheezo · Tickles – A trio stitched together from the darkest corners of the carnival. Every appearance feels like the lights have suddenly gone out.

9. Violent J · Shaggy 2 Dope · Jack Napier – Pure anarchy. If security loses control of the midway, chances are these three are standing in the middle of it laughing.

10. Chuckles the Sensitive Clown · Sloppy the Clown · Boss Clown – They may bring up the rear of the rankings, but nobody should mistake these clowns for comic relief. Under the Big Top, every painted smile hides bad intentions.

THE HALL OF SHAME

1. Every Six-Man Team That Never Left the Clown Car – Congratulations! You successfully avoided defeat this cycle...by successfully avoiding wrestling. While Doug McMaster, Buffo & Bongo, along with Mike Eaves, Forgiven Faith & Mr. Eaves, actually climbed under the Big Top lights, the rest of the division apparently got lost somewhere between the parking lot and the cotton candy stand. The Ringmaster has assured us the "Missing Performers" posters are already being printed. Maybe next cycle someone will remember there's a six-man division.

2. Mugzy – Every trip into the spotlight seemed to end with another pratfall. Defeats to Mr. Massive, Cody Steel, Sins, Reggie Brown, Busta Deeks, and The Deranged Mechanic made this a carnival run Mugzy would rather erase from the program.

4. Sgt. Slammer – It was less "mission accomplished" and more "mission abandoned." Defeats to The Deranged Mechanic, Sadistic Syd Slaughter, Guy Mann, Bozo's carnival of clowns, Razor, and Fire left Sgt. Slammer spending more time staring at the arena lights than the winners' circle.

5. The Undertaker – Someone forgot to tell Death that this carnival doesn't fear him. Losses to Fire (twice), Killer Kyle Carnage, The Deranged Mechanic, Boring Machine, Dude Mann, and Saberclaw turned what should have been a frightening tour into a long walk through the Hall of Mirrors.

HEADLINER

"Ultra-Violent" Chico Salazar

When the midway lights flickered on, one act stole the entire show. "Ultra-Violent" Chico Salazar didn't just win—he left a trail of broken bodies scattered throughout the carnival. Card after card, challenger after challenger stepped into the ring only to become another victim of his relentless assault. From opening bouts to televised showcases, Chico turned the Evil Clown League into his own personal house of horrors, piling up victories over active competitors while making short work of enhancement talent along the way.

Every great carnival has one attraction that people simply have to see. This cycle, that attraction wasn't the haunted funhouse or the clown car—it was "Ultra-Violent" Chico Salazar. His performance demanded attention from the moment the curtain rose until the final bell rang, earning him the distinction as this month's Headliner.

CENTER RING SPECTACULAR

League Championship : Fire vs. Masked Warrior
Card 8 – Mexico City • Main Event • 52:20

When the carnival lights dimmed and the spotlight settled on the center ring, two of the Evil Clown League's biggest attractions delivered a performance worthy of the final act. League Champion Fire and Rocky Mountains Champion Masked Warrior pushed one another for more than 52 minutes, refusing to blink as the crowd watched every near fall and every escape with growing anticipation. In the end, Fire clamped on the Figure Four, finally forcing Masked Warrior's resistance to crumble and preserving his place atop the Big Top.

The striped tent was filled with monsters, madmen, machines, and murderous clowns throughout the cycle, but for one unforgettable night they all became supporting acts. The spotlight belonged to Fire and Masked Warrior, whose unforgettable battle proved that beneath all the greasepaint and chaos, the Evil Clown League can still produce a true main-event masterpiece.

PIE IN THE FACE

Northeast Championship : Buffo def. Fire
Card 18 – Boulder · 27:57

Nobody saw this punchline coming.

For nearly the entire cycle, Fire stalked the Evil Clown League like an unstoppable force, leaving one battered opponent after another scattered beneath the Big Top. Then, just when everyone thought they knew how the show would end, Buffo stepped into the spotlight and delivered the oldest trick in the clown playbook—a perfectly timed surprise.

With one thunderous World's Strongest Splash, Buffo planted the League Champion squarely on the mat and walked away with the Northeast Championship, leaving fans, wrestlers, and even the Ringmaster staring in disbelief. Sometimes the biggest laugh isn't the joke... it's watching the carnival's biggest attraction get a pie square in the face.

This wasn't just an upset—it was the moment the entire midway stopped laughing and started gasping.

CROWD POPS (Top 5 Fan Favorites)

1. Buffo – *One moment can change everything, and Buffo's stunning victory over League Champion Fire sent the entire Big Top into a frenzy. The painted grin has become one of the most beloved sights in the Evil Clown League, proving that not every clown is out to terrify the audience.*

2. Fire – *Even in defeat, the League Champion remains the measuring stick for the entire promotion. Every appearance feels like the main*

event, and the fans continue to rally behind the man who survived another brutal cycle.

3. Bozo Dubbed Over – *The leader of the clown parade keeps proving that the carnival belongs to him. Successful tag title defenses and a fearless attitude have made Bozo one of the ECL's signature attractions.*

4. Tinkles – *Equal parts entertainer and troublemaker, Tinkles always leaves the crowd talking. Whether competing in singles or defending tag team gold, he has become one of the most recognizable faces beneath the striped tent.*

5. Bongo – *Every carnival needs a show-stealer, and Bongo continues to deliver. Between six-man championship success and his partnership with Buffo, the crowd never seems to tire of cheering whenever Bongo marches into the spotlight.*

NIGHTMARE FUEL (Top 5 Most Hated)

1. "Ultra-Violent" Chico Salazar – *If there is one name guaranteed to send chills through the midway, it's Chico Salazar. Every appearance ended with another battered opponent left lying in the ring. His brutality has made him the wrestler fans love to hate—and the one nobody wants to face.*

2. The Deranged Mechanic – *Somewhere between genius and insanity lies The Deranged Mechanic. Every match feels like another experiment gone horribly wrong, and his relentless destruction leaves fans wondering who'll become his next unfortunate test subject.*

3. Fire – *The League Champion doesn't ask for admiration—he demands respect. His dominance throughout the cycle left a trail of*

defeated challengers, making him one of the most feared attractions beneath the Big Top.

4. Sadistic Syd Slaughter – The name tells the whole story. Syd doesn't simply defeat opponents—he enjoys every painful second of doing it. Every walk to the ring feels like the arrival of the carnival's executioner.

5. The Undertaker – Even after a difficult cycle, The Undertaker remains one of the darkest figures roaming the carnival grounds. His presence alone is enough to make the midway fall eerily silent before the chaos begins.

UNDER THE BIG TOP – Top 10 Attendance

1. Zacatecas – 9,259 – The carnival pitched its tent in Zacatecas, and the crowd packed every seat. The midway was buzzing from the opening act to the night's unforgettable main event.

2. Warsaw – 9,059 – The audience came expecting chaos and left with exactly that. Championship bouts and brutal encounters kept the Big Top rocking all night long.

3. Slidell – 8,859 – The carnival rolled into town with a full slate of attractions, and the fans responded by filling the house to witness another memorable evening beneath the striped tent.

4. Helena – 8,866 – Helena embraced the madness, creating one of the loudest atmospheres of the cycle as the stars of the ECL delivered another unforgettable performance.

5. Chickasaw County – 8,117 – Every seat seemed occupied as fans gathered to see clowns, monsters, and madmen battle for supremacy under the Big Top.

"Ultra-Violent" Chico Salazar continues to leave a trail of destruction wherever he appears, while The Deranged Mechanic seems determined to dismantle anyone reckless enough to step into his workshop. Meanwhile, the evil clowns have tightened their grip on the tag team division, proving that behind every painted smile lurks another sinister surprise.

The carnival never truly closes—it simply folds the tent, packs away the clown car, and heads down the next dark road. Somewhere, another spotlight is waiting to shine. Somewhere, another victim is buying a ticket. And somewhere behind the curtain... the Ringmaster is already preparing the next act.

Until the Big Top rises again... keep one eye on the spotlight, one hand on your wallet, and never, ever trust a smiling clown.
