We'll also recognize the Rising Star of the Cycle, the Match of the Cycle, the Upset of the Cycle, and take a look at those competitors looking to reverse their fortunes in the Cold Streak Rankings. Whether you're chasing championships or climbing back into contention, every match matters in the HLL.

HLL Singles Power Rankings

1. Bio-Hazard

2. Old Dirty One Eye

3. Filthy Itch

One of the most active competitors in the HLL, Filthy Itch continues to collect meaningful victories while climbing the rankings. His aggressive style has made him a difficult matchup for nearly everyone placed in front of him.

4. Krimson Knight

Consistency has become Krimson Knight's calling card. A steady stream of quality victories has kept him firmly in the title picture, and another strong month could elevate him into championship contention.

5. Hawkeye Science

The TV Champion remains one of the league's elite competitors. Although many of his matches come against lower-ranked challengers, he has continued to defend his championship successfully while proving he belongs among the HLL's best.

6. Wild Child Ric Raven

Division Observation

6. The Trendsetter J.D. Slaughterhouse, Unforgiven Doc Ryder & Maverick Gunner McCabe

A dangerous combination that has picked up several quality victories. Their momentum continues to build, and another strong showing could move them into championship contention.

7. Dionysus, Aesculapius & Hawkeye Science

Loaded with individual talent, this trio is always capable of beating anyone on a given night. Their schedule has been limited, but whenever they unite, they're an immediate threat.

8. Avian Flu, Super Flu & Zigmond Timickle

An experienced unit that has enjoyed moments of success but has struggled to maintain consistency against the division's elite teams. They remain a dangerous opponent for anyone overlooking them.

If he continues this pace, don't be surprised if a championship opportunity is right around the corner.

Honorable Mentions

Krimson Knight

Quietly put together one of the strongest months in the HLL, steadily climbing the rankings with a string of quality victories. His consistency has made him impossible to ignore.

Wild Child Ric Raven

Continued to build momentum with several convincing victories while proving he belongs among the league's rising stars. Another strong cycle could move him into the upper echelon of contenders.

Match of the Cycle: Bio-Hazard vs. Hawkeye Science (Card 13 – Green Bay)

The League Champion met the reigning TV Champion in a rare champion-versus-champion showdown, and neither man disappointed. Hawkeye Science entered the bout carrying tremendous momentum, but Bio-Hazard reminded everyone why he sits atop the HLL by surviving one of his toughest tests of the cycle. It was the kind of marquee main event that fans hope to see, and Bio-Hazard's hard-fought victory only strengthened his claim as the most dominant wrestler in the league today.

Honorable Mentions

Old Dirty One Eye vs. Filthy Itch

Two of the hottest wrestlers in the HLL collided in a battle of rising contenders. Old Dirty One Eye continued his incredible run with another statement victory, further cementing his place among the league's elite.

Jake "Hangman" Seresin vs. Dionysus

One of the biggest surprises of the cycle saw Seresin score a hard-earned victory over one of the HLL's premier stars. The upset immediately elevated Seresin's standing while proving that no one is unbeatable.

Bio-Hazard vs. Mike Drake

A clash between the League Champion and one of the HLL's highest-ranked contenders lived up to expectations. Bio-Hazard weathered the challenge and added another marquee victory to his growing résumé.

With championship races heating up throughout the league, attendance figures suggest fan interest has never been stronger.
