Commissioner Joe Cochran: Jerry, if you're that determined to settle things, I've got good news. At our Summer Pay-Per-View, you'll get *Ryker Green*... inside a Steel Cage!

Jerry Tauts: Now hold on a minute! I never said anything about a cage! I just want a fair match, not to be locked in there with that lunatic! There has to be another way to handle this.

Downtown Kenny Vale: Well, it looks like the Commissioner has made it official!

Ray Mercer: Doesn't look like Jerry wants what he wants.

Ray Mercer: *Jim T. Halo* is wasting little time against *One Two Three Dude*, using his experience to keep the youngster off balance with solid mat wrestling and crisp arm drags.

Downtown Kenny Vale: *Halo* has been in big matches all over the Southeast, Ray. He's showing exactly why he was once the Southeast Champion.

Ray Mercer: *One Two Three Dude* fires back with a burst of speed, connecting with a dropkick that sends *Halo* reeling, but the veteran quickly regains control with a knee to the midsection and a hard elbow.

Downtown Kenny Vale: *Halo* is slowing the pace now. That's exactly where he wants this match.

Ray Mercer: *Halo* drops down, hooks the leg... he's got the Figure Four Leglock locked in! *One Two Three Dude* is trying to fight through the pain... he's got nowhere to go... and he submits!

Ray Mercer: The winner of the match, *Jim T. Halo*!

Downtown Kenny Vale: A textbook victory for the former Southeast Champion.

Ray Mercer: Wait a minute! Here comes *Mr. Stroke of Death*!

Downtown Kenny Vale: Look at that! No hands at all! That's tremendous ring savvy by *Jason Adams*.

Ray Mercer: *Referee Pops Pitstop* is in position... one... two... three!

Ray Mercer: The winner of the match, *Jason Adams*!

Downtown Kenny Vale: You don't see that kind of pinning combination very often. *Jason Adams* won that match as much with his wrestling IQ as he did with the Bionic Elbow.

Ray Mercer: Confidence is never in short supply with **Jason Adams**, and after the performance he turned in earlier tonight, you can understand why.

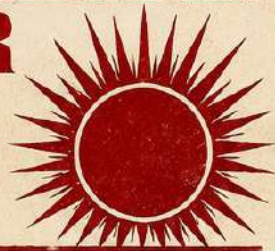
