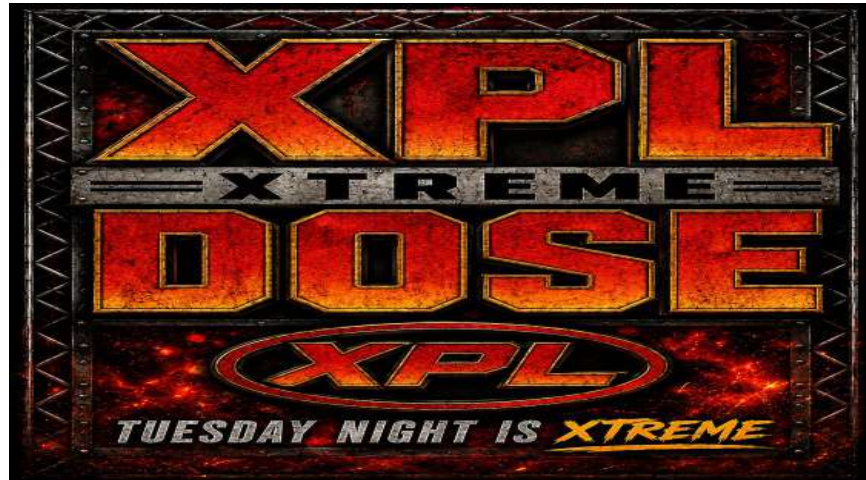

The opening of **Xtreme Dose** begins with the familiar sound of a limousine pulling into the backstage parking area of the sold-out **Xtreme Arena**. The camera focuses on the long black limousine as security rushes into position. The rear door slowly opens, and out steps the **XPL World Heavyweight Champion, The Mighty Deadhead**, wearing the World Championship proudly over his shoulder. The crowd inside the arena immediately erupts with a deafening chorus of boos that can be heard echoing through the building. Stepping out behind him is **Strong Machine's Mom**, smiling confidently as if she owns the place. Moments later, **The Mighty Mockingbird** exits the limousine with the **XPL Television Championship** draped over his shoulder, followed by the imposing **Demonic Gourdman**, whose cold stare never leaves the camera. The four walk together with complete confidence, looking every bit like the most powerful force in XPL.



Waiting nearby is backstage correspondent **Omar Rashaad**, microphone in hand, eager to get answers after the shocking events of **Sole Survivor: WarGames**. Omar quickly approaches Deadhead and asks if he has any comments regarding becoming the new XPL World Heavyweight Champion and the shocking betrayal of Voice of the Voiceless by Chris Marinaro. Deadhead slowly stops walking, removes his sunglasses, and stares directly into Omar's eyes before calmly saying, "when it's time for me to be heard... I'll be heard." Deadhead places his sunglasses back on, smirks slightly, and continues walking toward the arena without another word.

Omar immediately turns his attention toward **The Demonic Gourdman**, asking about the shocking return of **Sadistic San Quentin** and what it means for the race to the American Championship. Gourdman doesn't even acknowledge the question. He simply glares at Omar for several uncomfortable seconds before following Deadhead into the building, leaving Omar speechless.

The cameras then cut inside the sold-out **Xtreme Arena**, where thousands of screaming fans are on their feet as fireworks explode across the stage. The camera sweeps through the electric crowd, capturing homemade signs reading "**MARINARO SAVED NOBODY!**", "**VOICE WAS ROBBED!**", "**DEADHEAD ERA!**", "**WHO CAN TRUST MARINARO?**", "**XVX IS WATCHING**", "**GOURDMAN FOR AMERICAN CHAMP!**", "**SAN QUENTIN IS BACK!**", and "**RANKINGS MATTER!**" The atmosphere is unlike anything XPL has experienced in months as anticipation fills every corner of the arena.

The camera finally settles at ringside where, for the first time in over **five years**, **Ezekiel Gotti**, **Cameron**

Judas, and **Noah Atkinson** are seated together behind the broadcast desk. Gotti welcomes viewers from around the world to another explosive edition of **Xtreme Dose**, calling tonight the beginning of a new chapter in XPL history. Judas says the landscape of the company has completely changed after **WarGames** and promises that answers are coming regarding Chris Marinaro's shocking actions. Noah Atkinson adds that with the debut of the **XPL Power Rankings**, every match from this point forward carries championship implications, and tonight several superstars will begin climbing toward title opportunities.

As the commentators continue to hype the night's stacked card, the crowd suddenly erupts once again, signaling that **Xtreme Dose** is officially underway.

TRASHTALK MATTERS IN THE LEAGUE OF XTREME!



Since day one, the Xtreme Poison League has thrived on chaos, competition, and unfiltered attitude. And now, XPL Management is cranking up the pressure like never before. In the League of Xtreme, **TRASH TALK MATTERS**. It's not just about what you do in the ring, it's about what you bring to the mic. Your voice is your weapon, and XPL is giving you the platform to unleash it! From this moment forward, your shot at championship gold, pay-per-view placement, and a spot on the weekly "XD" card will be judged by three pillars of Xtreme: **Activity - Trash Talk - Wins**

As the crowd settles in, Ezekiel Gotti welcomes everyone back and shifts the focus to the debut of the XPL Power Rankings, explaining that while the fans didn't get to witness the first rankings matches on television, the system officially began over the weekend at XPL's live house events. Gotti reminds viewers that every victory now carries significant weight, as wins and losses directly affect a competitor's standing and bring them one step closer to earning a future **XPL World Heavyweight Championship** opportunity.

Highlights from the house shows begin rolling across the screen as Gotti recaps the opening results. **Voice of the Voiceless** picked up a huge victory over **Ares of the Olympians**, proving that despite losing the World Championship at **Sole Survivor: WarGames**, he remains one of the elite competitors in XPL. The footage then shifts to **Hijacked**, who earned an impressive Power Rankings victory over veteran **Eddie Raja**, giving the rising star a valuable boost in the standings. Finally, the cameras show **XPL American Champion Xavier Vaughn Xtreme (VXX)** defeating **Redwolf** in another highly competitive Power Rankings contest, further cementing his place among the company's top performers.

Gotti explains that because of those victories, Voice of the Voiceless, Hijacked, and Xavier Vaughn Xtreme have all climbed the inaugural XPL Power Rankings. He emphasizes that every competitor in the locker room now has a clear path to the top, and that every Power Rankings Match could dramatically alter the championship landscape.

"These aren't just exhibition matches anymore," Gotti says. "Every victory moves you up the ladder, every loss can send you backwards, and the higher you climb, the closer you get to what everyone in this business wants—a shot at the XPL World Heavyweight Championship."

Cameron Judas adds that tonight's edition of Xtreme Dose will feature the announcement of several more XPL Power Rankings Matches, while Noah Atkinson reminds viewers that with so many stars jockeying for position, every match could have championship implications. The commentators promise that by the end of the night, the rankings will already begin to take shape as the race toward the top of XPL intensifies.

As the commentary team wraps up its discussion of the XPL Power Rankings, the arena suddenly erupts into thunderous applause as **"The God of War" Hercules** makes his way onto the stage. The **X-Contenderz Champion** proudly wears his championship around his waist as he confidently walks toward the ring, slapping hands with fans along the entrance ramp. The ovation continues to grow as Hercules climbs onto the apron, steps through the ropes, and raises the championship high above his head. He signals for a microphone

while the crowd chants his name.

Hercules patiently waits for the cheers to die down before turning his attention to the massive **Countdown to Chaos** banner hanging high in the rafters. He says that in just a few short weeks, every championship in XPL will be on the line, including the title resting on his shoulder. Hercules proudly proclaims that he isn't the kind of champion who hides behind excuses or avoids competition. He says he is a **fighting champion**, and whoever earns the right to challenge him at **Countdown to Chaos** better be ready for the toughest fight of their career. Looking back up at the banner, Hercules says he'll be waiting for whoever survives the road to the pay-per-view before casually tossing the microphone aside and preparing to leave the ring.

Before he can step through the ropes, the mood instantly changes.

The crowd erupts with boos as **Sam McMillan**, **Saiga Genisys**, and **Nicholas Rysen** of the **Tombstone Masterz** appear together at the top of the entranceway. Without saying a word, the trio slowly marches toward the ring before separating and surrounding it from three different sides. Hercules stands his ground inside the ring as the three members of Tombstone Masterz begin climbing onto the apron, threatening to overwhelm the champion.

Just as it appears Hercules is about to be outnumbered, the crowd explodes once again. Charging down the entrance ramp come **Eddie Raja**, **Ares**, **Poseidon**, and **Perseus**. The four men hit the ringside area at full speed, forcing McMillan, Genisys, and Rysen to abandon their attack. Tombstone Masterz quickly retreat through the crowd as Raja and the Olympians pursue them into the arena, bringing the fans to their feet.

With the danger seemingly over, Hercules retrieves the microphone once more and smiles at the roaring crowd.

"So that's how you want to do it?" Hercules says. "Then tonight... we'll fight"! The audience erupts.

"Hercules... Eddie Raja... and the Olympians... against the Tombstone Masterz"! The announcement receives another huge ovation, but before Hercules can react, **CRACK!**

The arena gasps as **Redwolf** blasts Hercules from behind with a vicious forearm to the back of the head. The champion collapses to the canvas as Redwolf snatches the **X-Contenderz Championship** from the mat. Standing over the fallen champion, Redwolf grips the title with both hands before driving the championship belt directly into Hercules' skull with a sickening shot that echoes throughout the arena.

Redwolf kneels beside the fallen champion, picks up the X-Contenderz Championship, and slowly raises it over his head before pointing directly toward the **Countdown to Chaos** banner hanging above the ring. The message couldn't be any clearer. Suddenly, the Poison-Tron lights up.



The graphic remains on the screen as Redwolf stands over Hercules' motionless body, holding the championship high above his head while the crowd showers him with boos. The commentators question whether Hercules can recover in time for tonight's main event as **Xtreme Dose** fades to its first commercial break.



The lights inside the **Xtreme Arena** dim as a deep, ominous voice echoes throughout the building. The giant Poison-Tron flickers to life, displaying the words "**COUNTDOWN TO CHAOS**" before erupting into a montage of unforgettable moments. Slow, cinematic music begins to build as images of **Chris "The Kydd" Marinaro**, **Voice of the Voiceless**, and **The Mighty Deadhead** flash across the screen.

The video opens with highlights from **Sole Survivor: WarGames**, showing Marinaro surviving the brutal five-man war to become the **No. 1 Contender** to the XPL World Heavyweight Championship. The footage showcases his resilience, his determination, and his victory celebration before transitioning to the night's shocking conclusion. The music suddenly changes as the replay shows Marinaro racing to the ring during the World Championship match. Fans cheer, believing he's coming to save **Voice of the Voiceless** from **The Mighty Deadhead**. Instead, the replay slows dramatically as Marinaro drives a steel chair into Voice's skull. The arena fills with boos as Deadhead capitalizes moments later, pinning Voice to become the new **XPL World Heavyweight Champion**.

The package then shifts to the emotional aftermath. Voice is shown lying motionless in the ring while Deadhead celebrates with **Strong Machine's Mom**, **The Mighty Mockingbird**, and **The Demonic Gourdman**. Marinaro never celebrates with them. He simply stares at the fallen Voice before silently walking away, leaving the wrestling world searching for answers.

The screen fades to black before clips from the following edition of **Xtreme Dose** begin to play. Marinaro stands backstage and coldly declares, "*I saved the XPL.*" His chilling words echo throughout the arena as footage shows fans, commentators, and wrestlers reacting with confusion and disbelief. The video then cuts to Voice of the Voiceless, who watches the replay of the betrayal over and over again, his expression changing from heartbreak to determination.

The music begins to intensify once more as Deadhead is shown arriving at the arena as World Champion, refusing to answer questions and making it clear that when he chooses to speak, everyone will listen. Quick

flashes follow of Marinaro staring into the camera, Deadhead raising the World Championship high above his head, Voice glaring from the shadows, and the crowd passionately divided over who truly deserves to be called the face of XPL.

The narrator's voice finally breaks the silence.

"One man claims he saved the XPL..."

The screen shows Marinaro pointing directly into the camera.

"One man sits atop the mountain..."

Deadhead stands in the center of the ring with the World Championship raised high.

"One man wants answers..."

Voice of the Voiceless slowly clenches his fists.

"But only one man can leave Countdown to Chaos as the XPL World Heavyweight Champion."

The music reaches its crescendo as the screen rapidly cuts between Marinaro's steel chair shot, Deadhead's championship celebration, Voice's determined stare, and the World Championship itself. Fire explodes across the stage as the final image fills the Poison-Tron. A final line appears beneath the match graphic.

"Was Marinaro the villain... or the savior"?



The crowd erupts into a deafening mixture of cheers and boos as the commentators remind viewers that the biggest question in XPL may finally be answered at **Countdown to Chaos**, where the World Heavyweight Championship—and perhaps the future of the entire company—will be on the line.

As the emotionally charged video package comes to an end, the camera cuts back to the ring where **Chris "The Kydd" Marinaro** is already standing with a microphone in hand. The sold-out **Xtreme Arena** immediately erupts into a chorus of boos as chants of **"Voice! Voice! Voice!"** echo throughout the building. Marinaro allows the reaction to continue before calmly raising the microphone and once again declaring that he didn't betray anyone at **Sole Survivor: WarGames**—he **saved the XPL**. He says that before WarGames, the company had become predictable, the locker room had grown comfortable, and fans knew exactly what was going to happen every week. Since his actions, however, everything has changed. Marinaro boasts that television ratings are climbing, the match cards have become stronger than ever, former stars are returning to the XPL, and the wrestling world is once again talking about the company. He tells the audience that controversy creates conversation, conversation creates interest, and interest creates success. Looking directly into the camera, he says the numbers don't lie, the momentum is real, and whether the fans want to admit it or not, he has revived the XPL.

Marinaro then shifts his attention to **Voice of the Voiceless**, saying he knows Voice has been searching for answers ever since WarGames. He says that if Voice truly wants to know why he did what he did, then now is the time to come out and ask. As soon as those words leave his mouth, the arena lights suddenly go completely black. The sold-out crowd erupts in anticipation as several tense seconds pass in total darkness. When the lights finally return, **Voice of the Voiceless** is standing directly in front of Marinaro, face-to-face in the center of the ring. The audience explodes as neither man says a word, the tension becoming almost unbearable.

Marinaro finally breaks the silence by telling Voice that their rivalry is over. He says their series of matches has ended and there is no reason for another confrontation. Voice remains silent, never taking his eyes off Marinaro. Marinaro continues by saying that despite what everyone believes, he owes Voice absolutely no explanation. But if he has to give him one, then here it is. He says Voice's entire act has become nothing more than blatant gimmick infringement that's years old. He mocks Voice for hiding in darkness, appearing out of nowhere, speaking in riddles, and relying on the same mysterious presentation for years. Marinaro tells him that what was once original has become stale, and that perhaps it's time someone finally evolved the concept.

While the confrontation holds everyone's attention inside the ring, another story quietly unfolds outside of it.

The cameras suddenly catch **The Mighty Deadhead** climbing over the guardrail from the crowd with the **XPL World Heavyweight Championship** clutched tightly in his hands. The fans immediately begin screaming and pointing toward the ring as Deadhead slowly stalks behind Marinaro, waiting for the perfect opportunity.

Without warning, Deadhead charges forward and swings the championship belt with everything he has. At the very last second, Marinaro effortlessly sidesteps the attack, causing Deadhead to accidentally smash **Voice of the Voiceless** squarely across the head with the World Championship. The arena gasps as Voice crumbles to the mat.

Deadhead immediately realizes what he has done. His expression changes from confidence to disbelief as he stares down at the fallen Voice. Slowly, he drops the World Championship onto the canvas before looking up to find Marinaro staring directly back at him. Without saying a word, Marinaro calmly bends over and picks up the championship belt. The two men lock eyes in a tense staredown as the crowd buzzes with anticipation, wondering what will happen next.

Suddenly, the arena is plunged into darkness once again. The audience erupts as several long seconds pass without a single light inside the building. When the lights finally return, **Chris Marinaro is gone**. Even more shocking, the **XPL World Heavyweight Championship** has disappeared with him. Deadhead is left standing alone in the ring, furious and bewildered, while Voice of the Voiceless remains laid out on the canvas. The commentators are left speechless as Ezekiel Gotti points out the irony that Marinaro had just criticized Voice's long-standing mysterious persona before disappearing into the darkness himself with the World Championship, seemingly adopting the very tactics he had just ridiculed. As the confusion fills the arena, the cameras cut backstage where **Omar Rashaad** is standing by with the **XPL World Tag Team Champions, Wild Delivery**, ready for an exclusive interview.



Backstage, **Omar Rashaad** is standing by with the reigning **XPL World Tag Team Champions** and **PWI World Tag Team Champions, Wild Delivery**—**Chris Warner** and **Lukas Manukas**. Draped in championship gold, the duo exudes confidence as the crowd watching on the arena's giant screen showers them with a mixed reaction. Omar begins by acknowledging their incredible run atop the tag team division before asking the question that's been on everyone's mind. With **Countdown to Chaos** approaching and every championship scheduled to be defended, who exactly will challenge them?

Omar points out that no team has truly stepped forward to make a legitimate claim for the titles, leaving many fans wondering if the champions will even have opponents at the pay-per-view.

Chris Warner smirks before adjusting the championships resting on his shoulders. He reminds Omar—and everyone watching—that Wild Delivery isn't carrying one set of tag team gold, they're carrying **two**. Warner proudly says they are still the **XPL World Tag Team Champions**, still recognized as the **PWI World Tag Team Champions**, and perhaps the final PWI World Tag Team Champions the wrestling world will ever see. He says if a team has the guts to step up and prove they're worthy, Wild Delivery would have no problem putting **both** championships on the line.

"The problem isn't us," Warner says confidently. "The problem is nobody's proven they're good enough to stand across the ring from us. If there's a team out there that thinks they're ready, bring them both titles. We'll embarrass them twice."

Before Omar can ask another question, he suddenly places a finger to his earpiece as he's informed of breaking news from the production truck. His expression changes immediately as he looks back toward the champions.

"I'm just receiving word from Commissioner Venom Scott," Omar says. "Gentlemen... you *will* be defending the XPL World Tag Team Championships at **Countdown to Chaos**."

The crowd inside the arena erupts.

Omar continues.

"However... your opponents will once again remain a mystery until the night of the pay-per-view."

Warner and Manukas exchange a glance before Lukas Manukas slowly steps forward with a grin across his face.

"Mystery opponents?" he says. "Known or unknown... familiar or unfamiliar... it doesn't matter. Whoever Venom Scott finds... whoever walks down that aisle... whoever thinks they're leaving with our championships..."

Manukas taps one of the title belts resting on his shoulder.

"...they're going to find out exactly why we're the most dominant tag team in professional wrestling."

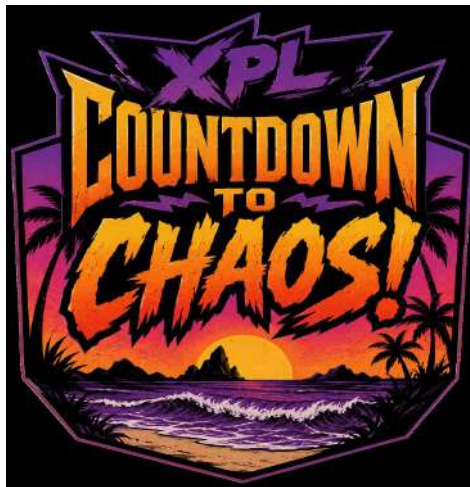
Warner raises both championship belts high into the air as Manukas finishes with one final statement.

"And when the smoke clears at **Countdown to Chaos**... we'll walk out exactly the way we walked in..."

The two champions say it together.

"STILL... XPL World Tag Team Champions!"

Wild Delivery stare directly into the camera as the commentators hype the mystery surrounding their opponents. The anticipation builds even further as the screen slowly fades to black before cutting to another commercial break, leaving fans speculating who could possibly answer the challenge at **Countdown to Chaos**.



As the screen fades to black, a thunderous orchestral score begins to build, accompanied by flashes of lightning streaking across the Poison-Tron before the familiar **Countdown to Chaos** logo tears onto the screen in a blaze of fire and steel. A rapid montage follows, showing bodies crashing through tables, steel chairs bending over backs, and scenes filled with blood, sweat, and determination as highlights from XPL's fiercest rivalries flash across the screen. The narrator's voice cuts through the music with intensity, declaring, "Chaos isn't coming... it's already here". The footage then shifts to Chris "The Kydd" Marinaro standing triumphantly atop the Wargames structure before abruptly cutting to his shocking betrayal of Voice of the Voiceless, with the crowd's outrage echoing throughout the arena as the image dissolves into Marinaro staring emotionless into the camera while the narrator

continues, "A hero became the most hated man in XPL..." The music intensifies as the XPL World Heavyweight Champion, the Mighty Deadhead, is shown raising the World Championship high above his head while standing over fallen opponents, the title gleaming beneath the arena lights before the screen freezes on Deadhead and Marinaro standing face-to-face as the narrator proclaims, "One man fights to remain king... the other believes destiny belongs to him once again". The screen then explodes with the official main event graphic displaying **XPL WORLD HEAVYWEIGHT CHAMPIONSHIP, THE MIGHTY DEADHEAD (c) vs. CHRIS "THE KYDD" MARINARO**, before the montage continues with quick shots of the Mighty Mockingbird defending the XPL Television Championship, Demonic Gourman destroying opponents with terrifying force, Strong Machine's Mom causing absolute mayhem at ringside, and several other XPL superstars preparing for battle. The narrator's voice grows louder with each passing second, declaring, "Championships will be defended... rivalries will reach their breaking point... and careers may never be the same again". The music reaches its climax as fireworks erupt across the screen, followed by one final message in bold metallic lettering reading **XPL PRESENTS COUNTDOWN TO CHAOS BULLETIN 331 WHERE SURVIVAL ISN'T ENOUGH... ONLY CHAOS REMAINS**. The logo slowly fades away as the sold-out Xtreme Arena erupts into cheers, the anticipation for Bulletin 331 reaching a fever pitch before the cameras return to ringside.

backstage

Backstage, the cameras catch up with the returning **Dragonite**, who stands alone in a dimly lit hallway with an intense look on his face.

The crowd inside the arena gives a loud ovation as Dragonite slowly looks into the camera, taking a moment before addressing the events of **Sole Survivor: WarGames**. He says that everyone has been asking about **King Cobra**, but he already knows exactly why Cobra hasn't been seen since their confrontation.

Dragonite says that after ambushing him at WarGames, King Cobra disappeared because he knew what was coming. He says Cobra knew the score had yet to be settled and decided the smartest thing he could do was run before Dragonite could return the favor.

"I get it," Dragonite says with a slight grin. "I'd disappear too."

His expression quickly becomes more serious as he admits that over the past several months, he's made mistakes—not inside the ring, but with the choices he's made. He says he trusted the wrong people, aligned himself with the wrong individuals, and allowed himself to lose sight of who he truly was. Those mistakes cost him friendships, opportunities, and nearly his career.

"But mistakes can be corrected."

Dragonite looks directly into the camera.

"And I intend to correct every single one of mine."

He promises that in the coming cycles, he'll begin making things right, one step at a time. Whether that means settling old scores, earning back respect, or carving a new path for himself, Dragonite says the XPL Universe is about to witness a different side of him.

He then leaves one final message.

"And one more thing... King Cobra..."

A brief pause follows.

"I'll be at **Countdown to Chaos**."

Dragonite smirks into the camera before walking out of frame, leaving his challenge hanging in the air as the scene fades to black.

The broadcast transitions to a sleek **Power Rankings** graphic on the Poison-Tron as dramatic music fills the Xtreme Arena. A narrator explains that beginning this cycle, the XPL Power Rankings will take on an entirely new role. While the original rankings that fans have followed for years will remain intact and officially reset this cycle, these new Power Rankings will exist separately and serve as the proving ground for championship opportunities. The narrator emphasizes that these rankings are designed to reward consistent performance inside the ring, with randomly selected matches featuring the league's highest-ranked competitors taking place throughout the cycle. Victories in those matches will determine who earns eligibility for future XPL championship opportunities, making every contest matter more than ever before. The

final message appears across the screen in bold lettering as the narrator delivers one last reminder: "Having **NO** trash talk will halt your rise to the top, but it won't earn you a championship either. Stay active. Compete. Contribute. Every match counts, every victory matters, and every superstar has the chance to climb the rankings on the road to championship gold." The graphic fades away, leaving the locker room and the XPL Universe with a clear message; earning a title shot has never been more competitive. The Top 10 are set. If a lower ranked wrestler defeats a higher ranked wrestler, they will move up 1 spot!

backstage

Backstage, The Demonic Gourdman storms through the hallways with purpose, his eyes scanning every corner as he searches for Sadistic San Quentin. Following San Quentin's shocking return and involvement in the American Championship picture, Gourdman is clearly looking to settle the score before Countdown

to Chaos. Officials and production staff quickly scatter out of his path as he marches deeper into the backstage area, calling out San Quentin's name and daring him to show himself.

Without warning, **XPL American Champion Xavier Vaughn Xtreme** explodes into the frame from around a nearby corner, a steel chair gripped tightly in his hands. **XVX** swings the chair at Gourdman, but Gourdman reacts just in time, causing the chair to glance off his shoulder instead of connecting flush. Fueled by adrenaline, Gourdman immediately tackles the champion to the concrete floor, and the two men begin throwing heavy right hands at one another. The steel chair clatters across the hallway as the brawl intensifies, with both competitors slamming each other into equipment crates, production cases, and the backstage walls. Neither man is willing to back down as officials desperately try to separate them.

The situation continues to spiral until a swarm of XPL security personnel and referees rushes into the area, pulling the two rivals apart before even more damage can be done. Gourdman repeatedly tries to break free from security's grasp, shouting that he isn't finished, while **XVX** yells back that he'll gladly finish the job at **Countdown to Chaos**. As the chaos finally settles, cameras continue searching the backstage area for **Sadistic San Quentin**, but there is no sign of him anywhere.

The broadcast then returns to ringside, where **Ezekiel Gotti** informs viewers that they have just received confirmation that **Sadistic San Quentin is not in the building tonight**, leaving everyone to wonder whether his absence is strategic or simply another mind game ahead of the pay-per-view. **Cameron Judas** notes that **San Quentin** has already made his presence felt without ever stepping foot into the arena, proving that his return has everyone on edge.

The camera then shifts to the ring, where **The Olympians**—**Hercules**, **Poseidon**, and **Perseus**—stand alongside **Eddie Raja**. Microphones in hand, the four men stare toward the entrance ramp as the crowd begins to buzz, knowing exactly who they're waiting for. Raja raises his microphone and wastes no time.

"Tombstone Masterz... get out here."

The arena erupts as the challenge hangs in the air, setting the stage for another explosive confrontation. The challenge is answered almost immediately as **Sam McMillan**, **Saiga Genisys**, and **Nicholas Rysen** emerge onto the entrance stage to a thunderous chorus of boos. The three members of **Tombstone Masterz** stand shoulder to shoulder, staring down **Eddie Raja** and **The Olympians** before confidently marching toward the ring. As soon as they slide beneath the bottom rope, diplomacy is thrown out the window. Raja meets McMillan with a running forearm while Hercules collides with Genisys, and Poseidon and Perseus swarm Rysen. The six men erupt into a wild, uncontrollable fight that spills into every corner of the ring as the sold-out Xtreme Arena comes unglued.

Despite being outnumbered five to three, **Tombstone Masterz** refuse to back down. McMillan fights with desperation, Genisys delivers stiff strikes from every angle, and Rysen absorbs punishment while continuing to throw bombs of his own. The numbers game eventually begins catching up to them as Raja and **The Olympians** start isolating each member of **Tombstone Masterz**, overwhelming them with constant attacks. Just when it appears **TM** is about to be completely overrun, **Redwolf** sprints down the aisle to a huge reaction. Without hesitation, he slides into the ring and blasts **Hercules** from behind, reigniting their rivalry

and evening the odds at four against five. The arena erupts as Redwolf repeatedly drives forearms into the X-Contenderz Champion before the fight completely breaks down once again.

What follows is absolute bedlam. Punches are exchanged from every direction as bodies crash into turnbuckles, men spill to the floor, and officials stand helplessly outside the ring, unable to restore order. The battle swings back and forth for several minutes, with neither side willing to give an inch. Eventually, however, Raja and The Olympians begin asserting control. Hercules floors Redwolf with a thunderous clothesline before turning his attention back to Genisys, while Poseidon and Perseus neutralize Rysen. Raja rocks McMillan with a series of right hands before all four men stand tall, systematically dismantling Tombstone Masterz. One by one, the members of TM are left battered inside the ring as the crowd senses the end is near.

Then, the atmosphere changes.

The audience suddenly rises to its feet as **The Dynamic Dragonite** appears at the top of the entranceway.

The camera cuts between Dragonite and the ring. Raja and The Olympians stop for a moment, watching cautiously, while the beaten members of Tombstone Masterz slowly begin looking toward the stage. The commentators immediately remind viewers that Dragonite has every reason to help Tombstone Masterz after the issues involving Eddie Raja and the group over recent months. Dragonite slowly begins making his way down the ramp, never taking his eyes off the ring. With every step, the crowd grows louder, wondering whose side he has chosen.

Halfway down the aisle, Dragonite suddenly stops.

He looks into the ring at Tombstone Masterz... then slowly shakes his head.

A knowing grin spreads across his face.

Without saying a single word, Dragonite turns his back on the ring and calmly walks back up the entranceway, leaving Tombstone Masterz to suffer the very same fate they allowed him to endure at **Sole Survivor: WarGames**. The crowd erupts as the realization sets in. Cameron Judas shouts that Dragonite has just repaid Tombstone Masterz in the most poetic way possible, while Ezekiel Gotti says revenge doesn't always come with fists—sometimes it comes by simply walking away.

Inside the ring, Raja and The Olympians continue standing tall over the fallen members of Tombstone Masterz as Dragonite disappears behind the curtain. The final image of the night is one of complete chaos: Hercules raising the X-Contenderz Championship high above his head, Redwolf recovering on the outside with his eyes locked on the title, Tombstone Masterz scattered throughout the ring, and the road to **Countdown to Chaos** feeling more volatile than ever.

The **XPL Xtreme Dose** end credits begin rolling across the screen as the cameras capture the electric crowd still on its feet, and the broadcast fades to black.

(as Xtreme Dose comes on the air, the camera does a quick pan of the crowd, before fixing on the tron. ***“Unseen footage after War Games...”*** scrolls across the screen, before it momentarily goes black. A few moments later, a camera is moving around the loading docks in the back of a building. It slowly moves around to the side, and shows someone sitting in the dark corner, holding what appears to be an hour glass. As the camera moves in, the crowd in the arena can be heard in the background cheering, as the figure becomes obvious. It is none other than the former world champion, Voice of the Voiceless. As he just stares at the hour glass, twirling it around from top to bottom, he slowly lifts his head to the camera. He reaches over, and lays the hour glass on the concrete above, and slowly starts to fall...)

VOTV: So, here we are....again. I'm sure if you think hard enough, this place where I sit will become very familiar to you. It was once a place that started what would be a very compelling story...or what we should call, the altering of a compelling story. It's a shame it has to come to this again, but your ego just couldn't let go. Just when the world thought there was only one true answer....YOU changed the question. Now, people want to know....What's next for the Voice?...I'm sure everybody would like to know the answer to that question. Well, let's take a look at the situation at hand before I shed some light on that question. You and I have a history like no other. We have been in many battles, for many titles, and many quests...with different outcomes every time. We have put differences aside, battled alongside each other, and even won tag gold together. We were never friends, but we two of the greatest rivals to ever step foot in that ring, sometimes putting the egos in check, and dominating as a unit. A few months ago, we wrote the final chapter in our historical book...or so I thought. We were done with the history. We closed the book, and agreed to move on from the history. Then your ego once again got the best of you. Deep down, you hated the fact that I was once again at the top of the food chain. As you got pushed aside by the fans, and peers alike, I once again showed the world that I was indeed the greatest wrestler in the history of the XPL. You knew your time was up, and you hated the fact that you once again had to look up to me. War Games was the place that I was suppose to finish another egomaniac off. I was going to put the Mighty Deadhead down, and send him back to mediocracy. It was a task that was meant to be...but again your ego couldn't let it happen. So you decided to inject yourself into the world title match.....YOU decided to call your own shot!....YOU decided that our story wasn't ready to end!...YOU decided that your jealousy, and your ego, would take control!....YOU decided that the only way to feel better about how far you have fallen, was to screw me out of MY world title!!! Now, back to that question.....What's next for the Voice?...

(He grabs the hour glass, stands up, and slams it against the wall behind him. He stares into the camera)

“SEE YOU SOON....”



A brief pre-recorded video interrupts the broadcast, and the Xtreme Arena erupts in boos as Chris "The Kydd" Marinaro appears on the screen. Dressed in black with an arrogant grin, he slowly paces before stopping and staring directly into the camera.

"Everybody wants to know why I did it. Why I betrayed the Voice of the Voiceless at Sole Survivor: Wargames. The answer is simple... because I had to."

"I walked into Wargames with one goal—to punch my ticket to Countdown to Chaos—and I did exactly that. I won Wargames. I became the number one contender to the XPL World Championship. And if betraying the Voice of the Voiceless was the price I had to pay to get there... I'd do it all over again without thinking twice".

"You call it betrayal. I call it eliminating the last obstacle standing between me and what belongs to me. The Voice was in my way, and obstacles don't get sympathy... they get removed".

"Now everybody's acting like I turned my back on the fans. I didn't turn my back on anybody. I gave you exactly what you've wanted for years. You wanted unpredictability. You wanted controversy. You wanted chaos. Well, congratulations... you're getting all three."

"Because of me, everybody's talking about the XPL again. Every locker room conversation, every fan discussion, every headline... it's all about me. I'm creating the kind of chaos that'll keep this company alive long after we're all gone."

"Voice... I know you're looking for answers. I know you're angry. If you're man enough to step into that ring with me, I'll give you every answer you're looking for. Face-to-face".

Marinaro pauses before turning his attention to the XPL World Champion.

"And Mighty Deadhead... you should be thanking me. Without me, Countdown to Chaos isn't the biggest event in XPL history. Instead, you want to play games and act like this is just another title defense."

"This isn't a game". "This is reality".

Marinaro slowly raises all five fingers toward the camera.

"I'm already a four-time XPL World Champion. At Countdown to Chaos, I'll become the first five-time XPL World Champion... and just like so many times before, it'll come at your expense".

"Enjoy carrying that championship while you still can, Deadhead... because the countdown to chaos is really the countdown to the return of Chris 'The Kydd' Marinaro to the top of the XPL".

The screen fades to black as the fans inside the Xtreme Arena rain down deafening boos.



Raja smirks for the first time during the interview.

"And when those three walk into that ring expecting another easy beatdown..."

"...they're going to discover that betrayal has consequences."

He stares into the camera for several tense seconds before walking away, leaving one massive question hanging over the road to Countdown to Chaos:

Who will stand beside Eddie Raja when he finally gets his chance at revenge against Tombstone Masterz?

The commentators immediately begin speculating about potential partners, reminding viewers that with every championship on the line and bitter rivalries reaching their boiling point, **Countdown to Chaos** is rapidly becoming the most unpredictable event in XPL history.



Backstage, the cameras catch up with the newly returned **Dynamic Dragonite**, who stands confidently with the **XPL Mid-Atlantic Championship** draped over his shoulder. The crowd responds with a loud ovation as Dragonite takes a moment to gather his thoughts before addressing the recent events that have surrounded his return.

Dragonite begins by speaking about **King Cobra**, saying that for the past two months Cobra made it his mission to disrespect him every chance he got. He says Cobra crossed every line imaginable, but deep down, Cobra knew exactly what the consequences would be. Rather than face those consequences, Dragonite claims Cobra chose the easy way out by requesting his release from the XPL. Dragonite shrugs and says he can't fault the decision because, in his words, "A smart coward knows when it's time to run." He smirks before adding that while Cobra may have escaped the fight, he'll never escape the reputation of walking away when things got too real.

Dragonite then turns his attention to **Tombstone Masterz**, acknowledging the growing war between the group and Eddie Raja. He reminds everyone that, years ago, he was the one who brought Tombstone Masterz together. It was his vision that laid the foundation for what the faction would eventually become. However, he says the group has chosen its own path, just as he has chosen his. There's no bitterness in his voice—only acceptance. Dragonite explains that every wrestler eventually has to decide what kind of legacy they want to leave behind, and Tombstone Masterz has made that decision for themselves. As far as he's concerned, they'll write their own story, and he'll write his.

Holding up the Mid-Atlantic Championship, Dragonite says capturing the title last cycle wasn't the

destination—it was only the beginning. It proved to himself and the entire XPL locker room that he still belongs among the elite. He promises the fans they'll see him at **Countdown to Chaos** in one form or another, and he's hopeful that whatever opportunity presents itself will be another step toward reclaiming his place at the top of the company. Dragonite says championships aren't won by looking backward; they're won by continuing to move forward, and that's exactly what he intends to do. He finishes by raising the Mid-Atlantic Championship high into the air before looking directly into the camera.

"This title was just the start. At **Countdown to Chaos**, I'm taking the next step... and the rest of the XPL better be ready."

Dragonite walks out of frame as the commentators discuss his renewed focus, his newfound confidence, and what role he may ultimately play at **Countdown to Chaos**, adding yet another layer of intrigue to an already stacked pay-per-view.



The scene opens from **Chris "The Kydd" Marinaro's** home in **North Carolina**, where he sits comfortably on the back porch overlooking a quiet landscape. The setting is peaceful, but Marinaro's expression is anything but. Resting beside him is a glass of bourbon, while behind him hangs framed memorabilia commemorating his four XPL World Heavyweight Championship reigns. He leans forward into the camera with a confident grin, making it clear that he has something to say.

Marinaro begins by addressing **The Mighty Deadhead**, saying he's heard everything the champion has had to say about respecting him. He nods in appreciation before explaining that respect is admirable, but it only takes you so far in professional wrestling. He reminds everyone that **Voice of the Voiceless** learned that lesson the hard way at **Sole Survivor: WarGames**. Marinaro says he respected Voice just as much as Deadhead claims to respect him, and Voice respected him in return. But once the XPL World Heavyweight Championship becomes the prize, respect no longer pays the bills.

"When the World Title becomes the primary focus," Marinaro says with a smirk, "respect turns into **'by any means necessary.'** No disrespect."

He chuckles before his tone becomes noticeably more serious.

"Everybody keeps asking me the same question... 'Chris, what exactly are you saving the XPL from?'"

He points directly into the camera. "I'll tell you."

"I'm saving it from bad storytelling."

He raises one finger.

"I'm saving it from terrible ratings."

A second finger.

"And I'm saving it from becoming a company dominated by one single entity."

He pauses.

"You people act like that's never happened before."

Marinaro leans back in his chair and smiles.

"There was only **one** entity that ever completely dominated the XPL... and the funny thing is..."

"...I was the man leading it."

He gestures toward the championship photos displayed behind him.

"Over a decade ago, the XPL reached heights people still talk about today. Attendance was through the roof. The locker room was stacked. Everybody wanted to be here. Why?"

"Because people tuned in to see what I was going to do next."

His confidence continues to build.

"So don't confuse arrogance with facts."

"The XPL's greatest era wasn't built by accident."

"It was built by Chris Marinaro."

"And now..."

"...it's going to happen again."

Marinaro stands from his chair and slowly walks toward the camera.

"It'll be me who brings that same level of prestige... that same level of notoriety... and that same level of excitement back to the XPL."

He stops just inches from the lens.

"And those..."

"...are words that you all can believe in."

After a brief pause, Marinaro shifts his attention squarely back to the World Heavyweight Champion.

"Deadhead..."

"I know you respect me."

"I respect you too."

"But at **Countdown to Chaos**, respect gets checked at the curtain."

"There won't be handshakes."

"There won't be admiration."

"There won't be mercy."

"There will only be one man leaving with the richest prize in this company."

He points directly at the camera as if Deadhead is watching from the other side.

"That championship is coming home with me..."

"...for a **fifth** time."

"And there isn't a damn thing you—or anybody else—can do to stop it."

Marinaro's smile slowly returns.

"People keep talking about the **Deadhead Era**..."

He shakes his head.

"It isn't resurrected."

"It never truly began."

He pauses for effect before delivering his final line.

"At **Countdown to Chaos**..."

"...the **Marinaro Massacre** begins."

Marinaro gives one final confident stare into the camera before the feed abruptly cuts to static, leaving the audience buzzing over yet another explosive statement from the self-proclaimed savior of the XPL and adding even more anticipation to one of the most anticipated World Championship matches in company history.

Chris Warner: "Countdown to Chaos is almost here, and we've spent the last few weeks asking ourselves one simple question: where's the competition? We've beaten Devon Demon & Aaron Matthews. We've beaten Da Hardcore Luchadore & Devon Demon. We've defended these championships against everyone that's been put in front of us, and now we're waiting for somebody to step up and prove they belong in the ring with Wild Delivery."

Lucas Manukas: "That's right! We're not sitting back here hiding from challengers. We're not making excuses. We're not dodging anybody. We're practically begging the XPL to send somebody after us. Somebody dangerous. Somebody hungry. Somebody crazy enough to think they can take these belts away. Because right now? I'm getting bored. I want a fight. I want somebody to make me earn this championship."

Chris Warner: "The XPL has one of the deepest tag team divisions anywhere in wrestling. We know the talent is there. We know there are teams watching us right now, convincing themselves they can do what nobody else has been able to do. Countdown to Chaos is your opportunity. If you think you're ready, then step forward."
